

HTML tags – First Simple Page

Anything inside these < > brackets is called a tag – this tag <html> means this is the start of a web page

The title of the page does not appear ON the page because it is in the head area – it shows on the browser tab though.

The body tag – start of the area of the page that DOES print on the web page.

Tags are closed using the / so </html> means this is the end of the web page – everything between these tags is part of the page

This is the start of the head area of the page – things inside this DO NOT print on the web page

This <h1> tag is a text tag – it makes the text into a heading – h1 is biggest – you can try h1 to h5 - The end tag shows when to stop making the text a headline

This tag <a ... > is an anchor tag in this case it points to another page a hyperlink – the text shown on the page is "Next Page"

This text is in a paragraph tag – it puts a space before and after the line.
